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Background

- User engagement is a state of interaction that involves cognitive, affective, and behavioral interaction with an application system that increase the belongingness needs of a user.
- The lack of user engagement towards DL indicating that there is a need to investigate further beyond the concept of traditional information system usage.
- A digital library is a collection of organized digital documents, objects, and services. It includes online databases, electronic journals, images, text, videos, and sounds (Alhaji, 2009).

Issues

- Not much is known about the contributing factors of DL engagement as well as its impacts

Benefits

- Institutional (i.e. Universities) – increase productivity (publication, research, innovation, consultation); reduce human resources (i.e. librarians to be employed) ; save space (i.e. building infrastructure)
- Individual - increase productivity (publication, research, innovation & consultation)

Problem

- DL is an expensive investment – it has to be used optimally.
- Users are more inclined to use generic search engines such as Google Scholars and free on-line resources e.g. Free and open access database
 - Free and open access database – limited in terms of scope & issue of quality
- Studies have shown that well developed DL will encourage users to deeply engage with the DL
- Previous studies on DL engagement did not comprehensively address contributing factors (determinants) as well as impacts of engagement
 - Impact was measured in terms of satisfaction only

Gaps

- Theoretical
 - Limited knowledge on DL engagement in relation of its determinants and impacts within the context of LIS.
- Practical
 - Lack of instrument to measure the determinant and impacts of DL engagement
- Empirical
 - Lack of empirical evidence on the relationship between DL engagement with its determinant and impacts especially in the context of Malaysian postgraduate student.

Research Question 1

How does DL engagement impact users emotionally and functionally?

Research Objective 1

To identify the users' emotional and functional impacts of DL engagement.

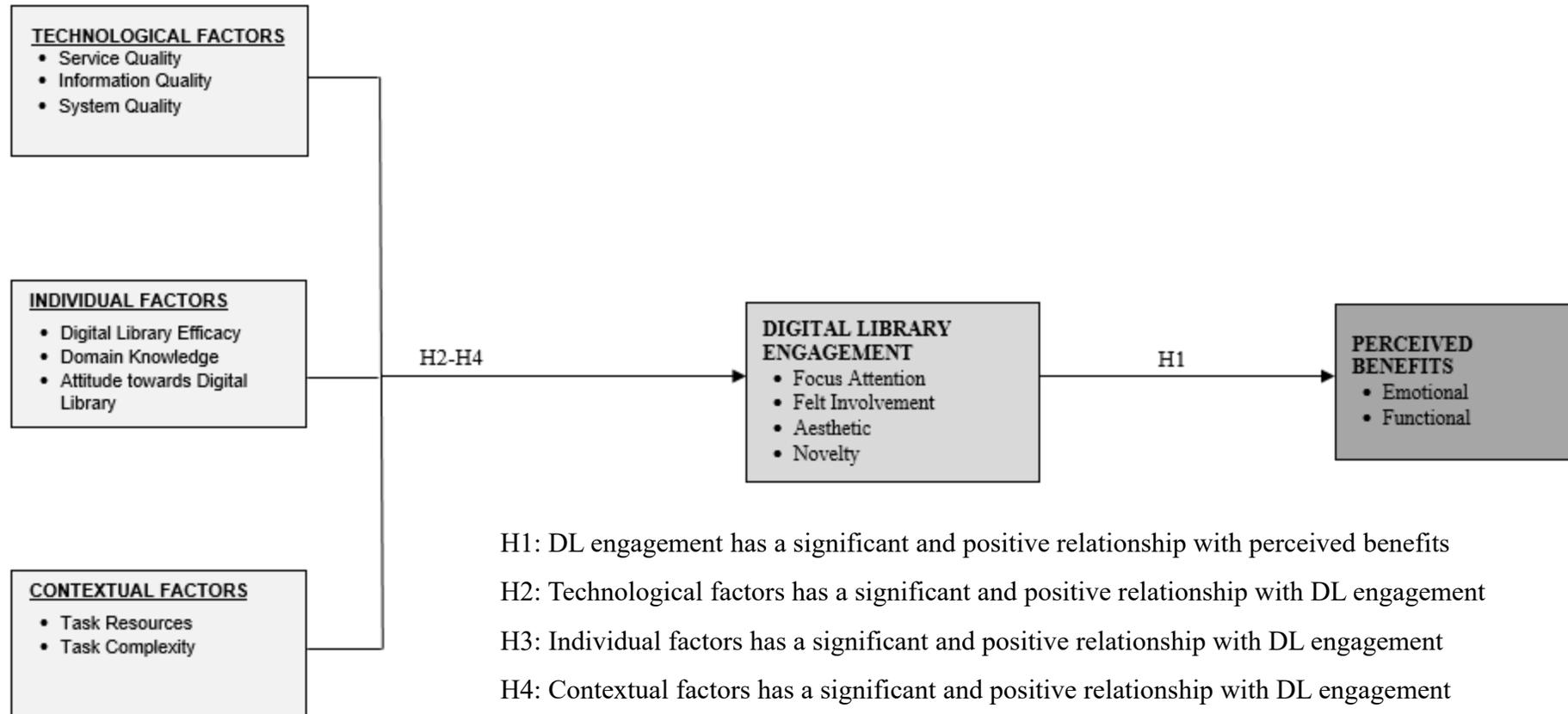
Research Question 2

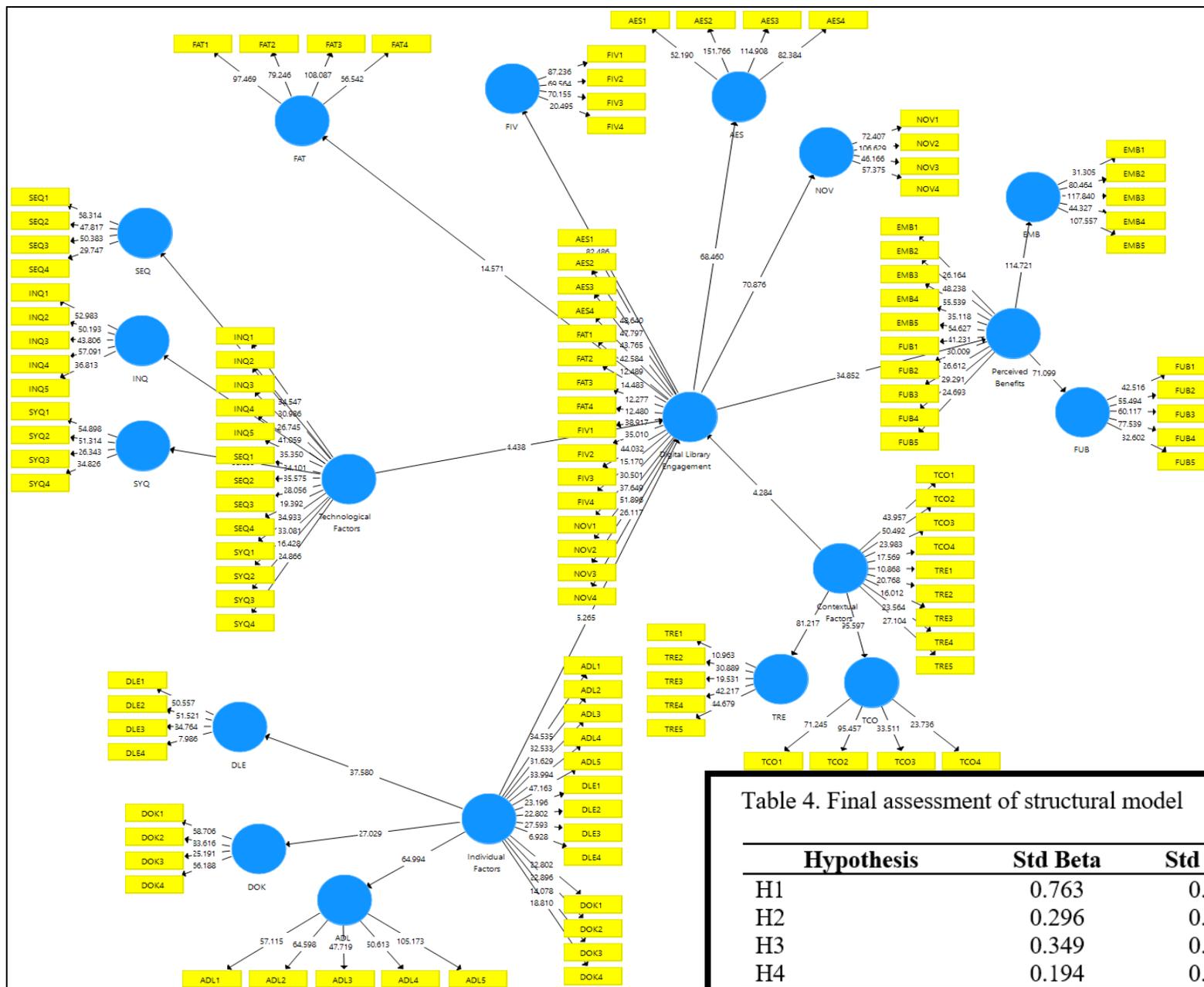

FINDINGS



Findings showed that technological factors, individual factors, and contextual factors were able to jointly predict the digital library engagement. On the other hand, digital library engagement also has a significant and positive relationship with perceived benefits.

Practitioners

Practitioners can use the factors identified in this study to improve the user engagement on DL.

Academician

Academician can use the model proposed in this study to further extend the knowledge on DL assessment, evaluation, and adoption.

DL Vendors

DL vendors may use the results of this study to further improve the performance and effectiveness of their product.

Government Policymakers

Government policymakers can use the result to develop a policy for the nation in the context of DL.

Body of knowledge

Filling the theoretical, empirical, and practical gap on DL engagement in relation to its determinants and impacts.

CONCLUSION AND LIMITATION

Conclusion

- The paper provides empirical evidence on the concept of DL engagement in relation to its determinants and impacts in the context of Malaysia;
- The paper provides a validated research instrument on DL engagement;
- The paper provides empirical evidence that contextual factors have a significant relation with DL engagement;
- This study has added to the body of knowledge in DL engagement

Limitation

- A future study should consider adopting more variables such as perceived usefulness, perceived ease of use, responsiveness, and subjective norm to improve the resultant research model.
- The study recommended that a widespread survey in the future to gain insight into the diverse demographic profile of respondents.
- A future study can improve the model by integrating other dimensions, such as organisational and socio-economic factors.
